8 Let the rivers clap their hands; Let the hills be joyful together before the Lord,

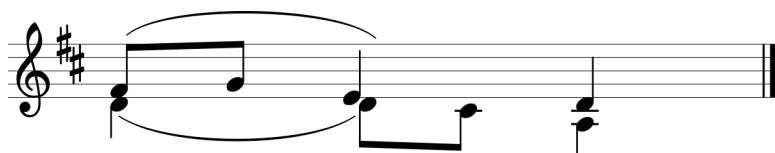

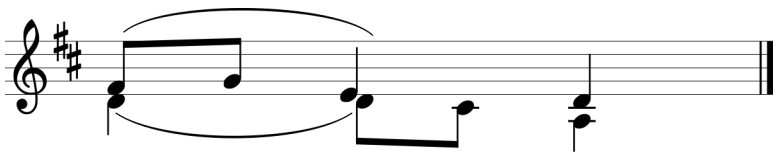

CONFESSION OF SINS

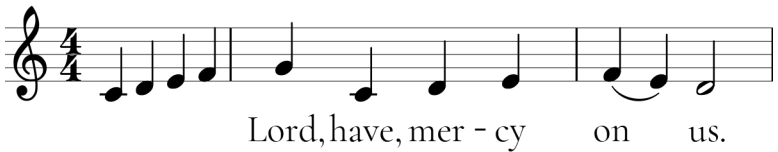

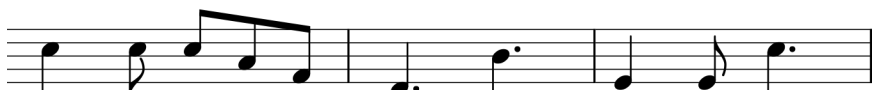

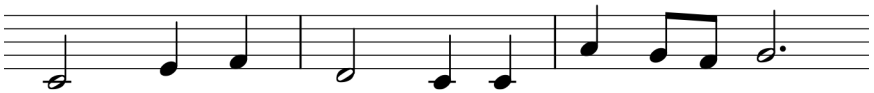

not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; ²¹ "that they all may be one, as You, Father, *are* in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

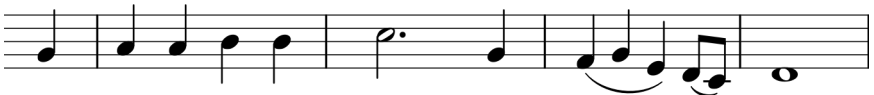
