## THE WORD

**Genesis 6:17-22; 8:1,18-22** <sup>17</sup> "And behold, I Myself am bringing floodwaters on the earth, to destroy from under heaven all flesh in which *is* the breath of life; everything that *is* on the earth shall die. <sup>18</sup> "But I will establish My covenant with you; and you shall go into the ark-- you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you. <sup>19</sup> "And of every living thing of all flesh you shall bring two of every *sort* into the ark, to keep *them* alive with you; they shall be male and female. <sup>20</sup> "Of the birds after their kind, of animals after their kind, and of every creeping thing of the earth after its kind, two of every kind will come to you to keep them alive. <sup>21</sup> "And you shall take for yourself of all food that is eaten, and you shall gather it to yourself; and it shall be food for you and for them." <sup>22</sup> Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did . . . Then God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the animals that were with him in the ark. And God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided . . .<sup>18</sup> So Noah went out, and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him. <sup>19</sup> Every animal, every creeping thing, every bird, and whatever creeps on the earth, according to their families, went out of the ark. <sup>20</sup> Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. <sup>21</sup> And the LORD smelled a soothing aroma. Then the LORD said in His heart, "I will never again curse the ground for man's sake, although the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; nor will I again destroy every living thing as I have done. <sup>22</sup> "While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, Cold and heat, Winter and summer, And day and night Shall not cease."

Matthew 4:18-22; 9:9-13 <sup>18</sup> And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen.<sup>19</sup> Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." 20 They immediately left their nets and followed Him. <sup>21</sup> Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets. He called them, <sup>22</sup> and immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him ... <sup>9</sup> As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "Follow Me." So he arose and followed Him. <sup>10</sup> Now it happened, as Jesus sat at the table in the house, *that* behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples. <sup>11</sup> And when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said to His disciples, "Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" <sup>12</sup> When Jesus heard *that*, He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. <sup>13</sup> "But go and learn what *this* means:'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.' For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."
