Even calls me by my name.








CONFESSION OF SINS


p We have come into the presence of God, who created us to love and serve him as his dear children.

THE WORD

Deuteronomy 6:4-15 ⁴ "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD *is* one! ⁵ "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. ⁶ "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. ⁷ "You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ⁸ "You shall bind them as a

sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹ "You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. ¹⁰ "So it shall be, when the LORD your God brings you into the land of which He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you large and beautiful cities which you did not build, " "houses full of all good things, which you did not fill, hewn-out wells which you did not dig, vineyards and olive trees which you did not plant -- when you have eaten and are full-- ¹² "then beware, lest you forget the LORD who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage. ¹³ "You shall fear the LORD your God and serve Him, and shall take oaths in His name. ¹⁴ "You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who are all around you ¹⁵ '(for the LORD your God *is* a jealous God among you), lest the anger of the LORD your God be aroused against you and destroy you from the face of the earth.

Acts 2:37-41 ³⁷ Now when they heard *this*, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men *and* brethren, what shall we do?" ³⁸ Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in

the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹ "For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." ⁴⁰ And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." ⁴¹ Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added *to them*.

SCHOOL BOARD

\$18,320 dollars in the school checking account New gravel was donated to the school and put on the playground behind the school.

The school year began on schedule on September 1. Faith Lutheran School is offering in person and virtual learning. The school has 17 kids enrolled in grade school, plus 5 preschool students. 5 of the 17 students have chosen to attend school virtually. Faith is following a no visitor policy. We are also taking students temperatures, requiring masks, and as much as possible maintaining six feet of distance between students.

Sunday school and bible class begin on Sunday September 13. Thanks to Dan Thiem, Heather Herbst, and Randi Golz for volunteering to teach Sunday school. The school board approved the purchase of the fall series of Sunday school material.

We have a total of six children enrolled in confirmation classes.
