## THE WORD

**Isaiah 25:6-9** <sup>6</sup> And in this mountain The LORD of hosts will make for all people A feast of choice pieces, A feast of wines on the lees, Of fat things full of marrow, Of well-refined wines on the lees. <sup>7</sup> And He will destroy on this mountain The surface of the covering cast over all people, And the veil that is spread over all nations. <sup>8</sup> He will swallow up death forever, And the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces; The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken. <sup>9</sup> And it will be said in that day: "Behold, this is our God; We have waited for Him, and He will save us. are invited, "See, I have prepared my dinner; my oxen and fatted cattle *are* killed, and all things *are* ready. Come to the wedding." <sup>5</sup> "But they made light of it and went their ways, one to his own farm, another to his business. <sup>6</sup> "And the rest seized his servants, treated *them* spitefully, and killed *them*. <sup>7</sup> "But when the king heard *about it*, he was furious. And he sent out his armies, destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. <sup>8</sup> "Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy. <sup>9</sup> 'Therefore go into the highways, and as many as you find, invite to the wedding.' <sup>10</sup> "So those servants went out into the highways and gathered together all whom they found, both bad and good. And the wedding *hall* was filled with guests. <sup>11</sup> "But when the king came in to see the guests, he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding garment. <sup>12</sup> "So he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without a wedding garment?' And he was speechless. <sup>13</sup> "Then the king said to the servants, 'Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and cast *him* into outer darkness; there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' <sup>14</sup> "For many are called, but few *are* chosen."

## SERMON

**Philippians 2:1-11** Therefore if *there* is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, <sup>2</sup> fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind. <sup>3</sup> *Let* nothing *be done* through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. <sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, <sup>7</sup> but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and* coming in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of* death, even the death of the cross. <sup>9</sup> Therefore
