THE WORD

Ephesians 6:10-20 ¹⁰ Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. ¹³ Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.¹⁴ Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness,¹⁵ and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; ¹⁸ praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints--¹⁹ and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to

make known the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰ for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Mark 7:14-23 ¹⁴ When He had called all the multitude to Himself, He said to them, "Hear Me, everyone, and understand: ¹⁵ "There is nothing that enters a man from outside which can defile him; but the things which come out of him, those are the things that defile a man. ¹⁶ "If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear!" ¹⁷ When He had entered a house away from the crowd, His disciples asked Him concerning the parable. ¹⁸ So He said to them, "Are you thus without understanding also? Do you not perceive that whatever enters a man from outside cannot defile him, ¹⁹ "because it does not enter his heart but his stomach, and is eliminated, thus purifying all foods?"²⁰ And He said, "What comes out of a man, that defiles a man.²¹ "For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, ²² "thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness.²³ "All these evil things come from within and defile a man."



THE NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by Whom all things were made; Who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. AUGUST MEETING NOTES

SCHOOL BOARD

School checking account is at \$12,389

Updated School handbooks will shortly be available.

Sunday School material for the fall has been ordered at a cost \$270.

We are planning a youth camp outing for next summer.

At this time Covid 19 protocols for the school year are as follows:

Masks are mandatory on the bus.

Masks are optional at the school

Teachers will attempt to sanitize classrooms and keep kids distant as much as possible.

Normal school activities will resume this year including, hot lunches, singing in church, school parties, and end of year programs.

Next school board meeting is scheduled for September 7, 2021.

COUNCIL MEETING

Total income for July was 17,138. Total expenses for July was 19,762. Net income for July was -\$2,624 \$7,500 was received in mission offerings in July.

Our treasurer took a \$5000 loan from the bank. With the loan our general checking account is currently at \$5,262.

Cole is providing LP for the church at \$1.43. They have also put remote sensors on the tanks.

The costs of photocopies on the copier is slightly increased.

Parts for the organ are on order. Fixing the organ will cost about \$2000. This money is available in the organ fund and the undesignated specials fund. But will deplete both funds.

The council decided not to move forward with the dedicated internet line.
